Cinvestav-Irapuato invites applications from outstanding young investigators for full-time academic positions at the assistant or associate professor level. Successful applicants will establish and maintain an externally funded innovative research program in Plant Sciences or related disciplines, and contribute to both the teaching and training of graduate students. Applicants must have a Ph.D. degree, at least two years of relevant postdoctoral training and notable scientific accomplishments. Basic knowledge of the Spanish language is desirable for non-native speakers.

Cinvestav-Irapuato Unit has 30 faculty members (37% women) leading research groups in four main research areas:

- 1. Plants and their interactions with other organisms and the environment;
- 2. Regulation, development and metabolism;
- 3. Ecology, genomics and evolution;
- 4. Computational biology and bioinformatics.

with a focus on food security and sustainable agriculture in drylands.
